Dear Seventh & Eighth Grade Parents/Guardians:

This year the Middle School is planning a special event for  $7^{th}$  &  $8^{th}$  grade students. On *Friday December 16, 2016 from 7:00 – 9:00 PM*, the eighth grade class will be sponsoring a  $7^{th}$  &  $8^{th}$  grade Winter Dance.

This event will be chaperoned by Middle School personnel and the Middle School's standards of appropriate behavior and dress will be strictly enforced. In addition to the general behavior expectations of the Middle School, the following rules will be in effect to ensure the safety and well being of all students attending the event.

- 1. This event is open to Lake Shore Middle School seventh and eighth grade students only.
- Students must be in attendance for the <u>entire event</u>. If for any reason, a parent wishes to have a child released early, written permission must be given to the head chaperone when the student arrives. Also, no one will be admitted past 7:30 PM, unless accompanied into the building by an adult.
- 3. Any Middle School student who, the week of the dance, is placed in the internal suspension room *(for any amount of time)*, or has been placed on Out of School suspension since the previous event, *will not be admitted*.

Admission to this event will be **\$5.00**. Refreshments will be available during the dance at no extra cost. Tickets will be pre-sold in the cafeteria prior to the dance.

Parents are reminded that this is <u>not a formal event.</u> Together with the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Class Officers, it has been decided that students are not to wear jeans. Any student who arrives wearing jeans will not be admitted. Students are encouraged to take pride in their appearance. Instead of jeans we suggest casual slacks or other informal clothing. It is not recommended that special outfits be purchased.
