Bastille	former prison burned down in Revolution, monument stands in its place
Bercy	Stadium for sports and concerts
Centre Pompidou	modern art museum
Champs-Élysées	most famous avenue in Paris
Hôtel des Invalides	former military hospital, now a museum where Napoleon is entombed
La Défense	represents the future, "window on the New World"
La Seine	River in Paris
La Tour Eiffel	the symbol of Paris, was meant to be temporary
Le Louvre	former royal palace; now most famous art museum with Pyramid
Le Métro	Paris subway system
Montmartre	hill where Sacré Coeur is located
Musée d'Orsay	art museum used to be a train station
Notre Dame	Our Lady Cathedral of gothic design
Opéra	Music Hall. The front looks like a wedding cake
Palais d'Élysée	where the French president lives
Place de la Concorde	where guillotine stood during French Revolution
Sacré Coeur	basilica made of white stone
