Sculpture Mrs. Zittel

Course Description - 1 Credit of Art/Full Year Course

Students in Sculpture will study a wide range of 3-Dimensional art concepts through hands-on exploration art materials. Students will gain knowledge in additive, subtractive and assemblage techniques. Students will use creative thinking and problem solving skills while exploring mediums and techniques. Students will gain an appreciation and understanding of art history and contemporary artists to develop their own creative vision and understanding of 3D design.

Course subject to change based on the hybrid/remote learning scenario

Students will work with the following materials in the creation of their artworks: Natural Found Objects: Rocks, Driftwood, Stones, and Shells

Wire Metal Plaster Concrete/Hydrocal Chicken Wire Cardboard Foam Steatite Stone

Grading

All projects and exercises will be averaged into the student's overall average. Students will also be responsible for small writing assignments, artist research, sketches, critiques, and self-evaluations. Students will receive a weekly participation grade for coming to class prepared with art kits and sketchbook assignments.

Final Exam

There are no final exam exemptions in the art department. The final exam grade is an art portfolio grade along with an artist statement. Students will document all of their projects throughout the year and maintain a digital portfolio. By the end of the year students will have a comprehensive portfolio that demonstrates their growth and understanding of sculpture.

Materials - You will be provided with a set of basic art materials in a ziplock bag, property of LSCSD, for use inside and outside the classroom. You will be responsible for replacing these items if you lose or break them during the year. Shared tools used in class will be sanitized in between classes. **The following additional materials are required for class:**

- 1. 9x12" spiral bound or hard cover sketchbook (not a sketchbook with glued/taped pages, they will fall out!)
- 2. 1 empty glass jar with a screw top lid, for taking home mod-podge and other supplies. I will take donations if you have extras at home!
- 3. Small cup for water, to keep at school (an empty small yogurt cup works great!)
- 4. Scissors, to keep in your art kit
- 5. Pencil, to keep in your art kit
- 6. Optional Hard case or tackle box for materials
