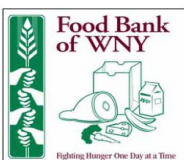
Ask About Our New CARES Emergency Home Delivery Program!

Our NEW CARES Emergency Home Delivery program assists low-income seniors ages 65 or older, disabled individuals or individuals/families without secure access to food due to the Covid-19 pandemic with obtaining nutritious food items to sustain a healthy lifestyle. Once a month, our friendly, Emergency & Family Services Team will deliver a bag of groceries to homebound individuals who are unable to visit a food pantry in their local community. This program is designed to assist clients who are able to prepare their own meals but lack the mobility to utilize a traditional food pantry.

ALL CLIENTS MUST PROVIDE:

Photo ID for Head of Household
Proof of Household Income for the past 30 days
Proof of Residence
Identification for all other household members

(Please see back of flyer for eligibility requirements)



In compliance with NYS Dept. of State eligibility requirements, all Emergency & Family Services clients are required to provide the following documentation:

- **State issued photo identification for the head of household**
(Examples: New York driver’s license, permit or non-driver’s ID, Benefit Card with photo)
- **Proof of address**
(Examples: utility bill, lease, landlord statement, bank statement)
- **Identification for all other household members**
(Examples: Social security card, benefit card, birth certificate)
- **Proof of income for the past 30 days**
(Examples: check stubs, bank statement, SSI/SSD award letter, TANF/Public Assistance Dept. of Social Services budget sheet, Unemployment Insurance determination letter, Workers compensation letter, Survivor’s benefits documentation, pension or retirement payment letter, rental income receipts, alimony or child support payment documentation, interest/dividends/royalties statements.)
