Brick repointing to repair deterioration on the High School chimney was planned as part of the District's Capital Project.

Once workers got to the top and looked inside, however, they also found deteriorated brick on the interior.

On these hot summer days, workers have been scaling up and down, inside and out, of the chimney to do the repair work.



The new High School addition continues to take shape, above. It's not as easy as just adding on another section of building, however. The old inside has to be adjusted to align with the new inside. Hence, below left, the a previous 2-story stairway had to be removed and, below right, a new two-story stairway will be constructed.









#### Capital Project Notes

from Campus Construction Management Project Architect Jill Burnett at Tuesday night's Board of Education meeting:

Work is ongoing at Middle School and High School. There have been some delivery delays of cabinetry due to Covid-19. Work continues to button up the HS addition before winter. This project continues through next summer.

At the Middle School, the new front office suite is complete, as are lobby restrooms outside the aud and new kitchen ceiling and lights. Sidewalks, paving and new parking lot configuration are complete. Aud renovation continues.

Phase 3 plan is under review at SED. Pending approval in October, bids go out in November. Work will include renovations to HS art, life skills, music and science rooms and a full auditorium renovation.

### HS Capital Project UPDATE ...



As the Capital Construction Project continues at the High School, the boys' pool locker room with new green lockers is completed, as are the new green bleachers in the pool area, and the new green bleachers and curtains in the gym. The indoor track will be completed by the end of December.

The tech rooms are furnished with cabinetry and tables. Finishing is being completed on the walls of the hallway connecting the new addition with the old building. Ductwork, plumbing and electrical are ongoing.

Outside, brickwork is beginning to cover the building, dark on the bottom, light on top. Doors and windows are going in. It's looking great and completion is targeted by next Fall.

### MS Capital Project UPDATE ...



At the Middle School, Capital Construction work has seen the completion of the Main Office and the offices for Principal, Assistant Principal and Nurse, which have been occupied since the start of school.

Meanwhile, work on the security entrance is ongoing, as is work in the auditorium, which is being completely renovated. Signs of progress in the aud are multiplying, with the installation of new carpeting in the upper balcony and the start of installation of new seats.

Also, lighting, including theatrical lighting, and the sound system have been demolished, making way for the new.



### Capital Project UPDATE ...



Here's a quick recap of what's done, what's underway and what's to come in Lake Shore's Capital Construction Project:

#### **PHASE 2 UPDATE:**

At the High School, the new indoor track is completed, windows and doors are installed in the new addition, and painting and drywall work continues. The entrance canopy is framed in, boarded and ready for glass (see photo above).

The second floor weight room floor has been water proofed, and wall tile is installed in the hallways, giving a modern look.

At the Middle School, the security entry doors and hardware are complete. Auditorium work continues, with all seats and carpeting installed. Sound and lighting work have proceeded slowly, due to COVID-related manufacturing delays.

#### PHASE 3 CALENDAR:

Contracts have been awarded for work at the High School and J.T. Waugh. Construction starts in February and ends in August 2022.

At the High School, projects include reconfigura-

tion and renovation of science, art, music and life skills spaces.

At J.T. Waugh, work includes a secure entrance, parking lot upgrades and sidewalk replacement.

#### PHASE 4 PLAN:

Young and Wright have started design development documents for work at the elementary schools. Works includes site work, plumbing, electrical, HVAC and technology upgrades. An initial playground planning committee meeting has taken place. Bids will open in September and be awarded in October. Work starts in November, with a completion date of November 2022.
