The rights have been sold to Alfred Music Publications!

"The hard work of the High School Band, music students, Music Department, and Music Boosters has once again paid off!," exclaims High School Band Director Eric Blodgett. "The compositional commission we worked so hard to plan and produce over the past 12 years has become a worldwide reality!" Mr. Blodgett announced that Alfred Music Publications, one of the two biggest music publishers in the world, has already purchased the rights to the Rossano Galante Lake Shore Commission "Champions of the Sky." "Normally, this takes at least a year for publishers to review and compare to other submissions, sometimes never amounting to anything, but they were so impressed by the collaboration composition and the professional recording we submitted of the Symphonic Band from the Spring concert that they wanted to buy the rights before any other publisher beat them to it," he said. "This is a huge accomplishment for our department, district, students, and Boosters organization."
