In other matters, the Board of Education:

- **Authorized taking the steps necessary to begin operating the District’s Universal PreK program** and to solicit Requests for Proposals from community-based organizations to collaborate for the operation of one (1) Universal PreK classroom, beginning in the 2024-2025 school year.

- **Authorized submission of an application to participate in New York State's Electric Vehicle Charging Station Make-Ready Program.**
The program would provide funding for installation of charging stations that could be used by students, employees,

residents, or visitors to school events.

In this program, the District would pay National Grid’s wholesale rate for the electricity. Users would swipe their debit or credit card and pay the retail rate. The District would use the difference to offset other costs.

If approved, installation would likely be in the last row of the High School student parking lot, where the lawn backs up toward Tim Hortons.
