Senior Moving Up Day

Caps, Gowns & More Delivered by 37 Volunteers



Senior Moving Up Day is traditionally conducted at the High School but in this drastically different year it was taken directly to seniors' homes.

Thirty-seven volunteers from the District personally brought Moving Up Day to the homes of 222 Lake Shore seniors last week. During the six hour marathon delivery, each volunteer delivered to 6-10 students. Some traveled in caravans, delivering to 12-15 students. They presented seniors with their caps, gowns, yearbooks, and celebratory baskets containing a t-shirt, face mask, candy, cards, Varsity letters from athletics and balloons, provided by the Senior Class and Student Government.

A "special delivery" was made during the visit to Colin O'Neill, when he surprised Cindy Ceppaglia with this year's yearbook dedication, voted by the entire senior class. Mrs. Ceppaglia has worked at Lake Shore since 2001 and has been Colin's personal care aide since Kindergarten. She's often referred to as the "class mom" by seniors. Colin provided this quote for the yearbook:

"I want to give a big thank you to Mrs. C. who has been by my side for the past 13 years. She is a kind-hearted, generous, and compassionate person who is not only a huge help to me but a friend and helper to many of the class of 2020. I have appreciated her guidance and support throughout these years and have enjoyed being her sidekick."
