GRADING:

All projects, assignments, papers and tests will be graded and averaged into the student's course average. Projects and assignments are due on the specified due date. Late projects and assignments will not be accepted and a grade of "0" will be given. Plagiarizing, copying other student's work, or cheating of any kind will not be tolerated and a grade of "0" will be given.

1. Unless otherwise noted, each art project will receive three grades according to the following criteria. Please be aware that lengthy projects may have grades doubled according to the amount of classroom time used to create the artworks.

- a. Originality
- b. Understanding of Concepts
- c. Technique and Workmanship

2. Written homework assignments or sketches will be graded 0-10 points. Homework will not exceed more than 20% of your final grade.

3. Final exam project will be given at the conclusion of the course and will be worth 20% of the final grade average. **There are no exemptions in the Art Department.**

4. All students will receive a weekly participation grade based on punctuality, preparedness, effort, positive contributions to the classroom, appropriate use and care of materials, and following room rules.
