a PERSON, PLACE, THING, or IDEA (computer, feet, class, Shelby))

VERB

an ACTION word (and also the word "IS") (collect, run, turn, ate)

ADJECTIVE

DESCRIBES a NOUN, tells WHAT KIND, HOW MANY, or WHICH ONE (dirty, round, two, rough, strange)

ADVERB

DESCRIBES a VERB, tells WHEN, WHERE, HOW, or HOW MUCH (quickly, hard, downstairs, yesterday, very)

PRONOUN

a word that takes the PLACE OF A NOUN (he, she, it, they, them, mine, I, we, our)

CONJUNCTION

CONNECTS words ("FAN BOYS") (for, and, because, yet, so, although, however)

PREPOSITION

shows a
RELATIONSHIP
between NOUN and
ANOTHER WORD (on,
from, into, under, over,
in)

shows STRONG FEELING (Hi!, INTERJECTION Neat!, WOW!, Yuck!)
