Polytheism

the belief in MANY gods (Hinduism)

Reincarnation

coming back to life as another living thing "soul rebirth"

Hinduism

NO known founder- Caste system, Reincarnation, Karma

Caste system

a social group into which someone is BORN

Buddhism

Founded by
Siddhartha
GuatamaEightfold Path,
Four Nobel Truths

Buddha

"enlightened one"

Judaism

Homeland of Israel- Torah holy writings

Christianity

Jesus Christ is the son of God

Archeologist

a scientist that studies human history by digging up human remains and artifacts

BCE

Before the birth of Christ

Migration

the MOVEMENT from one country, place, or locality to another

Neolithic Era

NEW Stone Age

Artifact

a simple man-made object such as a tool or a piece of art representing a culture-PRIMARY SOURCE

Bands

Stone Age people used to meet their BASIC NEEDS

Hunting and Gathering Led to need to cooperate with each other and SPOKEN LANGUAGE

Development of Agriculture (farming)

people were no longer limited to the food that they could find or hunt
