The school board, superintendent, district office staff, and school-based staff to include the administration, the teaching staff, the clerical staff, and the custodial staff should all play a role.

Provide information and support.

Do not ask, "Do you need anything?" Instead identify what new staff members are most likely to need in: instructional support, professional support, personal support, logistical support ... and provide it!"
