We are beginning our third quarter of the year. Second quarter report cards and progress notes were mailed yesterday 1/31. I am happy to report that our students continue to thrive each month while developing their activities of daily living and work based learning/employability skills.

Our February Unique Learning System unit theme is titled "Respectful Relationships," we address the topic of getting along with others. The unit provides lessons and activities about the importance of using appropriate social skills when interacting with different people, including activities in the Transition Passport: Personal Life/Relationships. As we assist our young adults in the transition from school to work, it is necessary that they receive training in navigating a variety of relationships. This unit will provide our young adults with the tools needed to learn how each relationship has different rules and social expectations and how our behaviors should reflect this. The unit also emphasizes the importance of respectfully interacting with people who are different from ourselves.

We will be going on a field trip to Cala's Kitchen on Thursday, February 13th.

The students will be able to order a lunch from the menu and socialize with their classmates for a pre-Valentine's Day Celebration! There will be no cost for the students for this trip.
