Happy New Year Everyone! We hope you all enjoyed your holiday winter recess and are ready to start off a happy and healthy New Year for 2020!

Personal Safety is presented in this month's Unique Learning System Unit titled, "Who Can I Trust?" The unit provides lessons and activities focusing on recognizing unsafe situations and what to do about them. Activities from the Transition Passport: Daily Living/Safety Tools as well as Personal Life/Relationships are incorporated. As we assist our young adults in the transition from school to work, it is necessary that they receive training in personal safety. Knowing what to do in unsafe situations, knowing who you can trust and how to stay safe on the internet are important components to personal safety. This unit will provide our young adults with the tools needed to learn about how to stay safe and make safe, responsible choices.

Last month our community outing was to Braymillar Bowling Lanes in Hamburg. All the students had a wonderful time as this has become one of our yearly traditions before the holiday recess. This month we will be attending the showing of "Doctor Doolittle" at the Angola Theater on Tuesday, January 21st at 10:30 am. There is no fee and lunch will be provided at school.
