Hello Lake Shore Families,

Happy New Year! We hope you have enjoyed your winter recess and are ready to get back to work on our individual goals for the year! We were unable to attend our December field trip to Chick's due to one of our snowdays, but we have rescheduled for the end of January.

Our Unique Learning System monthly theme is, titled "Safety Matters," where we address the topic of home safety. The unit provides lessons and activities about the importance of home maintenance and upkeep, including activities in the Transition Passport: Daily Living / Safety. As we assist our young adults in the transition from school to work, it is necessary that they receive training in keeping their homes maintained and safe. This unit will provide our young adults with the tools needed to focus on safety rules and procedures at home, with special emphasis on safety while using handheld tools and appliances.

We will continue our weekly schedules with shopping at Tops on Tuesdays, internships at Tops, Cala's, and AJ Schmidt School on Wednesdays. We look forward to cooking in our kitchen on Thursdays, and skating at SABAH on Fridays.

There will be a parent questionnaire/survey sent home in the next two weeks which will help me create the new IEP's for next year. The more specific information you can give me about the physical, social and academic needs and or concerns of your child the better. I use every bit of information given, for the parent voice component, which is required in the document.

Parents are very important team members and I appreciate you taking the time to assist in the effort to create this very important plan for next year.

If your student is exiting this year, I would not be creating a new IEP, but an Exit Summary and you would not need to fill out the IEP Parent Survey.
