Dear Lake Shore Families,

We are combining the last 2 months of our newsletter with end of the year information. Please mark your calendars for the upcoming important dates, as we approach the end of our school year.

Our Unique Learning System unit in May is titled "What to Do, What to Do." We address the topic of making good decisions. The unit provides lessons and activities about tools and a Four-Step Process for making effective decisions. As we assist our young adults in the transition from school to work, it is necessary that they receive training in thinking through the good and bad consequences that can happen as a result of the choices they make and the importance of learning from our mistakes. This unit will provide our young adults with the tools needed to understand what can affect our decisions and reflect on how our decisions are important.

Our Unique Learning System unit in June is titled "Wash. Dry. Fold. Repeat." We will address the topic of laundry care. The unit provides lessons and activities about the basics of laundry care. As we assist our young adults in the transition from school to work, it is necessary that they receive training in the steps of doing laundry, from pre-treating stains and sorting clothes, to reading care tags and properly putting clothes away. This unit will provide our young adults with the tools needed to learn to care for their clothing as an important independent living skill.

We will be going on a field trip to the Erie County Botanical Gardens on Friday, May 16th, and also go out to lunch for pizza afterwards.
