We are in full swing of our daily routines. We are shopping at Tops in Derby on Tuesdays. Our internships have started on Wednesdays at either Tops, Cala's Kitchen, or AJ Schmidt School. Skating has also begun with SABAH on Fridays. Our students are continuing to get customer service skills and stocking shelves while they are all working in our school store as well. Our weeks are very busy as our students are gaining wonderful experience in the community, in addition to working each day on their individual IEP goals in the classroom.

Our Unique Learning System unit this month is titled "Time to Travel". In this unit we address the topic of safe and responsible travel. The unit provides lessons and activities about the importance of time management and personal safety, including activities in the Transition Passport: Daily Living / Safety and Recreation and Leisure / Emergency Contact Cards. As we assist our young adults in the transition from school to work, it is necessary that they receive training in self advocacy. Self-advocacy begins with knowing about yourself, your rights and the types of assistance available to you. This unit will provide our young adults with the tools needed to learn about themselves so they can speak up more effectively. We are observing Veterans Day on Monday, November 11th. There will be no school on this day. We thank all of our community members that have served in our nation's military Armed Forces. We are grateful for your service.
