The construction in the front of the school has been completed and we are excited to return to our Life Skills classroom in the West wing of the high school - Room 119!

We will continue to develop our home-school connection by providing a monthly newsletter given each month to share our upcoming lesson themes and activities. We will continue to use the Unique Learning System Curriculum- Transition Level which is designed to address Life Skills that will enable our students ages 16-21 to become more independent as they move toward adulthood at home and in the community.

The ULS theme for the month of September is "Speak Up for Yourself", which addresses the importance of self-advocacy. This unit will provide our young adults the tools needed to learn about themselves so they can speak up in a more effective manner. A ULS Parent newsletter will also be sent home each month detailing lessons throughout the month.

I am in the process of contacting businesses for the Community Based Instruction (CBI) Internships, which are an important component of the Life Skills curriculum. These internships will not begin until mid-October. You will be notified in advance when we are ready to begin. In order to begin the internships, all permission slips must be signed and returned to school. I will make follow-up calls to make sure these papers have been received and have an opportunity to speak with each family. I will also need a signed permission slip/medical form completed for our monthly field trips as well. We appreciate your cooperation in returning the slips in a timely manner.

We are also in the process of setting up our field trips for the entire year and will send out a list as soon as it is complete.

Our Open House at the High School will be on Thursday, September 19th at 6:30 in Room 119. You will be given an outline of our daily schedule, curriculum and other important information for the year. I look forward to seeing you there!
