

EVANS TOWNSHIP LIONS CLUB, INC. SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The Evans Township Lions Club, Inc. will be accepting applications for two (2) scholarships this school year and in

years to come. These scholarship awards will be named "The Evans Township Lions Club, Inc. Community Service Scholarship" and will be in the amount of \$750.00 each. All previous scholarship awards presented by the Lions Club are discontinued.

Applicants must be residents of the Town of Evans, but need not be attending the Lake shore Central School system. Any resident high school senior may apply regardless of what high school they attend, (St. Francis, Eden, Immaculata, etc.). Also applicants are not limited to seniors planning on attending traditional 4 year colleges but also included are applicants planning on attending a junior/community college, trade or professional school as a continuation of a B.O.C.E.S course of study, or joining a work/training program like an apprenticeship.

Recognizing that the Lions Club motto is **"We Serve"** we are looking for students who mirror this in their actions and attitude towards others and their community. Therefore applications should be in the form of a letter containing the student's name and address and a convincing description of how they plan to serve and effect positive change in the world. (This letter should be 250 to 300 words.

This letter should be accompanied by written recommendations from significant adults involved in the applicant's life outside of the family who could speak to the level of involvement in community service as well as the character of the applicant. Any recommendations will be considered as attachments and should not be included in the 250 or 300 word count of the application letter. Applications and attachments should be returned directly to the **Evans Township Lions Club Inc., Attention: Scholarship Committee, PO Box 342, Angola, NY 14006,** no later than **April 21, 2020**.

We, as members of the Lions Club look forward to cooperating with you in spreading the word about these scholarships hoping those seniors who may be reluctant to submit application for the more traditional scholarships may apply for these awards. We hope to help students who might otherwise have difficulty continuing their education post high school.
