Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

We hope you are looking forward to another great year at Lake Shore High School and that you are enjoying the summer! Before school resumes, we would like to inform you that:

On Thursday, August 22nd and Friday, August 23rd we will be taking applications for parking permits, between the hours of 7:00am - 3:00pm.

In order to be considered for driving privileges students must have earned the required credits to be considered a junior or senior. Students must also be in good standing in regards to academics, attendance, and conduct. To maintain driving privileges, students must comply with all NYS motor vehicle regulations. <u>Student parking on campus is a privilege, not a right, and may be revoked at any time if terms of agreement are violated</u>.

In this packet and on the high school webpage you will find a packet with Parking Regulations, Parking Permit Application, Cell Phone Free Driving Pledge, and Student Parking Checklist (please check to make sure your registration and insurance cards are up-to-date). Please bring in a fully completed copy of each document when you apply for your parking permit or you will not be able to apply and receive a hang tag at that time. Additionally, students can apply for a parking permit throughout the school year.
