Hello Lake Shore Families,

We cannot wait to have your children back in our building. We have spent our summer preparing for their return the week of September 8th. It has been too long since we have been able to see their smiles and hear their voices!

We will begin the school year in a Hybrid Model. What does that mean you ask? We will have 50% of our students in the building on Tuesdays and Wednesdays (Team Green – last name A - J) and 50% of our students in the building on Thursdays and Fridays (Team White – last name K - Z). Students attending CTE programs (Carrier, LoGuidice, Maple, PTech) will be on the White team (R/F) to align with the different out of district programs. All students will be remote on Mondays. Where ever possible we have tried to place students from the same family on the same team from K- 12. Families will receive communication specific to their children identifying which team they are on if changes from the above alphabet breakdown were needed. If you have questions please reach out to your building Principal.

Students will need to be aware that we have changed our high school schedule as shown below. We will not be offering 10th period until further notice. This means that **all students will need to exit the building at 2:35 pm. 1st period begins at 7:40 am. The building will open in the morning at 7:20am.**

Entering the building will also be a different process for the 2020 – 2021 school year. We are installing thermal cameras at our Main Entrance (bus pu/drop off) and our North West Entrance (parent pu/ drop off at the beginning and end of the day). The cameras will provide instant feedback on elevated body temperatures. We will pull students aside for elevated temperatures as well as for calibration checks of our equipment. Students will be moved into a separate location where they will be rechecked. Anyone still showing an elevated temperature will be taken to the Nurse's office for further evaluation using the DOH guidelines. All students will need to enter through one of these two doors. Students displaying a temperature before coming to school should stay home and seek medical advice. All students will be provided with a cool Lake Shore mask on the first day. They may also choose to wear one or their own.

Access into the building for students after the school day has started will only be through the Main Entrance.

Due to climate changes related to COVID 19 we will not be allowing our students to use Tim Horton's passes until further notice. We will re-evaluate this change at the end of the first semester.

If a student needs to be picked up during the day, parents/guardians will need to bring a photo ID and wear a mask. For everyone's protection parents/guardians will not be able to enter the building without a mask. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter.

Student schedules will be mailed home on September 1st. They will also be visible on Power School at that time. Students should bring their schedule with them on their first day of school.

We look forward to holding our annual New Student Orientation. In keeping with our hybrid school reopening model, we will hold the New Student Orientation sessions on September 2nd & 3rd. Families will be receiving information with the details of when they should attend in the near future.
