DAILY OPERATIONS

Regular Hours: 9:00am – 3:00pm

Extended Hours: 7:00am – 9:00am

3:00 pm – 6:00pm

This year, Eagle's Landing will be at the High School.

Campers will only be released to those individuals on the authorized pick-up list. **Identification is REQUIRED. No exceptions!**

We know that sometimes your hectic schedule presses you for time and every second is valuable, however the safety of your child comes first. Please be patient and allow yourself a few extra minutes for identification to be confirmed.

WHAT TO BRING EVERY DAY

- Sneakers
- Water bottle
- Appropriate clothing for indoor and outdoor play
- Lunch, if you'd like, and snacks if part of the extended day (clearly labeled)
- Sunscreen (staff will NOT apply)
- Swimsuit & Towel

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Electronic Devices (cell phones, iPods, etc., are not permitted)
- Toys/Games
- Sport Equipment
- Expensive Items/Money

HOURS

It is imperative that no child be dropped off earlier than 7:00 am and every child must be picked up promptly at 6:00 pm. Please have alternate arrangements in case you cannot pick up your child. Please note that transportation is **NOT** available.

LUNCHES

The CEP Program provides lunches daily. Lunches will be served by Personal Touch. You may choose to send a lunch with your child. Because no refrigeration is available, we ask parents to send lunches in insulated bags or small coolers that are clearly labeled. We do not provide utensils, straws, etc. Please, no glass containers.

SNACKS

Please send your child with an extra snack or two if you plan for them to stay for the extended day. Snacks will not be provided.

MEDICATION

Any child that requires medication(s) during the course of the day must leave it with our Health Director. All medication(s) must be accompanied by the appropriate physician's script authorizing administration of the medication(s). Campers are not permitted to have medication of any kind in their possession during camp hours.

FIELD TRIPS

As always, we plan to have several field trips and special guests.

The cost of field trips is included in the Registration Fee.

DISCIPLINE

We want campers to have fun and enjoy their summer. The district Code of Conduct will be followed. When behavior is disruptive and discipline is needed, the counselors will attempt to correct the situation with verbal redirection. If this is not effective, the child will be removed from the situation and parents will be

informed. If a child is continually putting themselves or other campers in danger through aggressive behavior; camp privileges will be lost. The camper may also be removed from the Eagle's Landing Program.
