DAILY OPERATIONS

Campers will only be released to those individuals on the authorized pick-up list. **Identification will be REQUIRED. No exceptions!**

We know that sometimes your hectic schedule presses you for time and every second is valuable, however the safety of your child comes first. Please be patient and allow yourself a few extra minutes for identification to be confirmed at dismissal.

WHAT TO BRING EVERYDAY

- Sneakers
- Appropriate Clothing
- Bagged Lunch (clearly labeled)
- Sunscreen (staff will NOT apply)
- Swimsuit & Towel
- Face covering/mask

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Electronic Devices (cell phones, iPods, etc. will not be permitted)
- Toys/Games
- Sport Equipment
- Expensive Items/Money

HOURS

It is imperative that no child be dropped off earlier than 7:00am and picked up promptly at 6:00pm. Please have

alternate arrangements in place in case you cannot pick up your child. Please note that transportation to and from home is **NOT** available.

If your child is attending academic summer school, we can transport between the Middle School and High School. Please let us know if your child will attend both programs.

LUNCHES AND SNACKS

Please send your child with a lunch and snack everyday. Due to the fact that we have no refrigeration available, we ask that parents send lunches in insulated bags or small coolers that are clearly labeled. We do not provide utensils, straws, etc. Please, no glass containers.

MEDICATION

Any child that requires medication(s) during the course of the day must leave it with our nurse. All medication(s) must be accompanied by the appropriate physician's script authorizing administration of the medication(s). Campers are not permitted to have medication of any kind in their possession during camp hours.

FIELD TRIPS

As always, we will plan for several field trips. This planning includes locations where safety protocols such as social distancing and masks can be maintained.

The cost of field trips is included in the Registration Fee.

DISCIPLINE

We want campers to have fun and enjoy their summer. When behavior is disruptive and discipline is needed, the counselors will attempt to correct the situation with verbal redirection. If this is not effective, the child will be removed from the situation and parents will be informed. If a child is continually putting themselves or other campers in danger through aggressive behavior; camp privileges will be lost. The camper may also be removed from the Eagle's Landing Program with no refund.
