There will be NO Program on Monday, July 4th in observance of Independence Day.

The cost of field trips is included with the registration fees.

Trip details will be shared as information is confirmed.

To allow for proper planning and hiring of staff we are requiring a registration commitment. Please complete and submit a registration form to the Main Office of the W.T. Hoag Educational Center along with a deposit of \$25.00 before May 20, 2022. Complete payment, in full, is not required until Friday, June 17, 2022. Registrations not paid in full by the deadline will be cancelled and the deposit refunded.

Daily lunch, snacks and transportation are not provided for the Eagle's Landing program. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items; please do not send your child with anything valuable.

Drop Off Times are between 7am – 9am
all expected students should arrive by 9am.
Pick Up Times are at 3pm and 6pm.

These scheduled drop off and pick up times allow for better organization and program scheduling. Please let us know if you have an extenuating circumstance.

We are able to transport students between school buildings that are also participating in the Lake Shore Summer School Program as necessary.
