General Registration Information

The Lake Shore Central School Year Driver Education program is open to students currently enrolled in the Class of 2023, Class of 2024 and Class of 2025. Students must have attained the age of sixteen (16) years by November 1st, 2022, and hold a valid New York State Driver's permit or, a valid New York State Driver's license. **Registration must be done at the William T. Hoag Educational Center, between 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. The last date for registration is Wednesday, October 26th, 2022.** Registration is on a first come first serve basis with preference for Lake Shore students. Late registrations will be placed on a waiting list. **Cell phones must be turned off and put away during class and driving sessions.** *Proper footwear is expected, no sandals or flip-flops.*

Schedule

Classes will begin on Tuesday, November 1st at 3:30 p.m. and classes will continue until Tuesday, March 7th. All classes will be held at the High School. Your confirmation of assigned times for driving session and lecture class will be provided after the registration period ends. Driver Education will not take place on snow days or days when after school activities are cancelled. *Driver Education instructors may also adjust the schedule as needed due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.* Any cancelled classes will be made up as determined by the instructors.

Attendance

In order to receive MV-285 certificates students must attend *every* driving session and *every* lecture class. DMV requires specific time in class, driving and observing while on the road.

****Attendance is crucial****

Please do not register for Driver Education if you know you will miss instruction for any reason.

Length of Classes

Each session will be 90 minutes in length. Students must complete 24 hours of classroom instruction and 24 hours of experience in an automobile. **Classes and Road Groups will be begin promptly** following the posted schedule. Participation in Driver Education is a privilege. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and could dismiss you from participation.

Fees

A \$425.00 fee will be charged and collected at the time the registration is submitted.

The registration fee of \$425.00 is not refundable after November 1st, 2022.

Course Credit

High school credit cannot be awarded for completion of this course. An insurance reduction form will be issued to students who successfully complete the classroom portion of the program (65% final average) and the laboratory (automobile final average of 65%) portion of the program separately.

Transportation

There will be no transportation provided by the Lake Shore Central Schools to or from this program. Unlicensed vehicles (mopeds, dirt bikes, ATV's) may not be used to transport students to or from the Driver Education program.
