Luggage will be dropped off first thing in the morning on April 3rd. We will depart from the High School at 3:30 that afternoon. We will return late in the evening on Monday, April 8th (anticipating 8pm) As in our previous four tours to Florida, students would miss 3 days of school (Thursday, Friday, and Monday) and are responsible for all missed school work.
