PICKLE BALL STUDY GUIDE - 6th & 7th GRADE

Pickle-Ball was created during the summer of 1965 on Bainbridge Island- a short ferryboat ride from Seattle, Washington. The original purpose of the game was to provide a sport for the entire family. Initially, families played Pickle-Ball in their backyards on a hard surface, on driveways and on residential dead end streets. Since the mid-70's Pickle-Ball has grown and expanded from a family activity game to a net court sport with formalized rules.

GAME- Is played to **11** points: however, a team must win by **2** points.

SCORING- A team shall score a point only when serving. A player who is serving shall continue to do so until a fault is made by their team.

BOUNDRY LINES- All lines are considered good.

SERVE- Player must keep one foot behind the end line when serving. The serve is made underhand. The server must hit the ball in the air on the serve. You are not allowed to bounce it and then hit it.

The service is made diagonally cross court and must clear the net. The receiving team must let the ball bounce once on the serve.

Only **one** serve attempt is allowed. **Both** members of each team will serve before the ball is turned over to the opposing team.

VOLLEY- To hit the ball in the air without first letting it bounce

FAULTS-

- * Hitting the ball out of bounds
- * The ball not clearing the net
- * Ball bounces two times
- * Volleying a serve
