TENNIS STUDY GUIDE - 8th GRADE

Tennis is a sport usually played between two players (<u>singles</u>) or between two teams of two players each (<u>doubles</u>). Each player uses a <u>racket</u> to strike a tennis ball over a net into the opponent's <u>court</u>. The modern game of tennis originated in the <u>United Kingdom</u> in the late 19th century as "**lawn tennis**". After its creation, tennis spread throughout the upper-class English-speaking population before spreading around the world. Tennis is an Olympic sport and is played at all levels of society at all ages. The sport can be played by anyone who can hold a racket.

<u>Serve</u>

must be overhand (Underhand in PE classes) serve diagonally from behind the endline alternate sides after each point is scored <u>Let Serve</u> - serve that hits the net and goes over. Get a second try.

<u>Scoring</u>

Love - 15 - 30 - 40 - <u>Game</u> Must win 6 games to win the <u>set</u> Must win 3 sets to win the <u>match</u> Either team may win a point on the serve.

<u>Forehand</u> - hitting the ball from the dominant side with the front of your hand facing outward

<u>Backhand</u> - hitting the ball from the non dominant side with the back of your hand facing outwards

<u>Singles</u> - One player vs. one player. Smaller court size. Same scoring system.

<u>Doubles</u> - Two players vs. two players. Bigger court size. Same scoring system.

Duece - When the score is tied at 40-40.

<u>Volley</u> - Hitting the ball out of the air without a bounce.
